3. Name and appropriate accessibility requirements will be disclosed to transport providers, accommodation and conference venue where assistance may need to be arranged.
4. Name, email address and affiliation will be held by 3rd Plant Microbiome Symposium keeping you informed about the planning of the conference. 3rd Plant Microbiome Symposium will share this information with a number of secure third parties in order to fulfil your order. This includes:
